Interfaith/Interagency Network of Charlotte County

The 2004 hurricane season brought undue devastation on Charlotte County. Representatives from local faith- and service-based organizations banded together to develop a non-profit corporation to serve as the long-term disaster recovery group for Charlotte County. Over thirty non-profit and government agencies in Charlotte County are partners working together with IINCC to coordinate and develop resources so that families get their lives back to the way it was before the storms.

The goal is to survey every single home in Charlotte County, assess the hurricane-related needs, and guide homeowners on the path to recovery.

Through an initial assessment, the needs of the resident are identified. Volunteers are then recruited and coordinated to make the needed repairs, rebuilding our community one family at a time.

Dozens of faith-based, service-based, non-profit and government agencies in Charlotte County are represented through IINCC's efforts. We are the hub in your wheel of resources to help homeowners recover and rebuild. We're local and we're here for the long haul.

Meeting the Needs of the Community

IINCC's primary focus is on the repair and rebuild of residences within Charlotte County. However, IINCC is also able to offer residents financial, emotional, spiritual, and housing resources through the coordinated efforts of many different organizations.

Our Case Manager conducts needs assessments and identifies appropriate resources to help the resident.

Volunteers from around the country come to Charlotte County to assist in meeting the needs of our residents. They are scheduled and housed by our Volunteer Coordinator.



Our Project Coordinator oversees the cost and materials needed for each rebuild and directs the work of the volunteers.

IINCC is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization governed by a voluntary Board of Directors.

Referrals

Through door-to-door canvassing, phone calls, and walk-in visits, IINCC assesses hurricane-related needs of residents within the county. By coordinating with both local and nation-wide organizations, IINCC is able to accept referrals from other organizations as well.

Mission

The mission of IINCC is "To proactively coordinate and develop resources so that disaster victims become and remain survivors."
